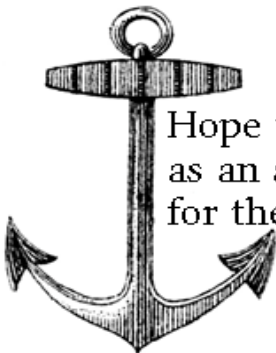
Trustee Update!
